Project Title:

- **Monstrous Mummy Candy Bowl**

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Medium or large glass bowl
- Cheesecloth
- Teabags and water
- Scissors
- Hot glue gun
- Black and white felt
- Candy

- Dress It Up “Candy Corn,” “Fright Night,” “Spiders!” and “Happy Haunting” button packs

DIRECTIONS:

1. Put teabags and warm water in your glass bowl and stain the cheesecloth to your liking before hanging it up to dry.
2. Dump water and teabags out of the bowl and allow the bowl to dry.
3. While waiting for the bowl and cheesecloth to dry, cut and layer felt for eyes and mouth and cut the shanks (or loops on the back) off of your Dress It Up buttons.
4. Once everything is dry, cut your cheesecloth into jagged 2” strips and turn the bowl upside down. Hot glue the end of a cheesecloth strip to the bottom of the bowl and slowly begin wrapping and gluing the cheesecloth around the bowl. Make sure to wrap irregularly and have fun!
5. Once you have wrapped the cheesecloth to your liking, you can begin putting the eyes and mouth on your mummy, as well as your Dress It Up buttons.
6. Taking a small strip of cheesecloth, cover the top and/or bottom of the mummy’s eyes to make them look like they are under the cheesecloth.
7. Fill the bowl with candy and enjoy your Monstrous Mummy Candy Bowl for Halloween!

Skill Level: Easy

Approximate Crafting Time: About 30 minutes (not including drying time)
